Donate: Every contribution, big or small, helps us continue our vital work.

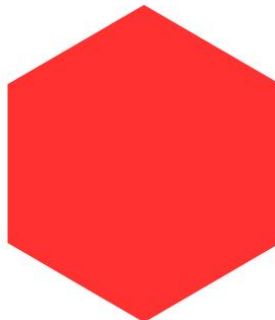
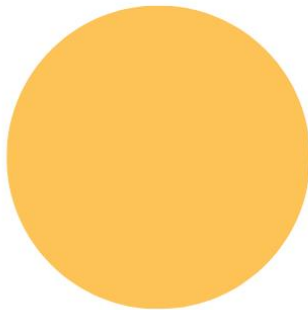
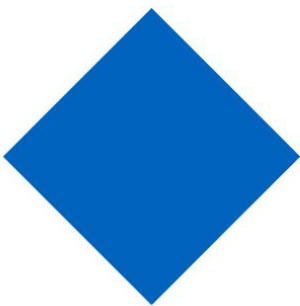
Spread the Word: Share our mission with friends and family to help us reach more people.
